July - Think Cool Thoughts

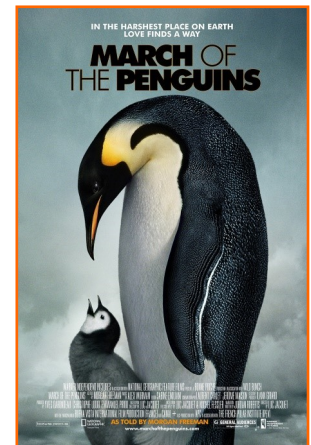
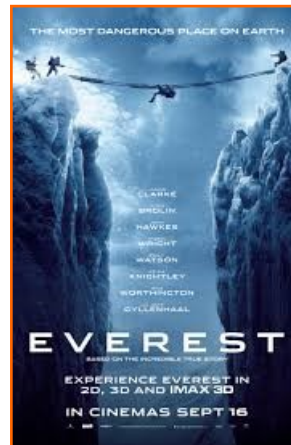
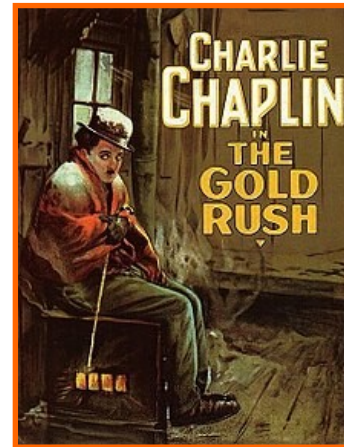
Join us at 5:30 p.m. in our Community Room for our VPL Thursday Evening Film Series!
