Cinema in Paradise

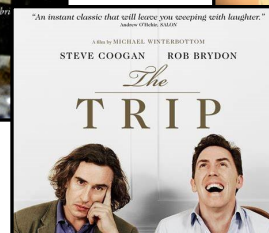
Join us at 5:30 p.m. in our Community Room for the VPL Thursday Evening Film Series!

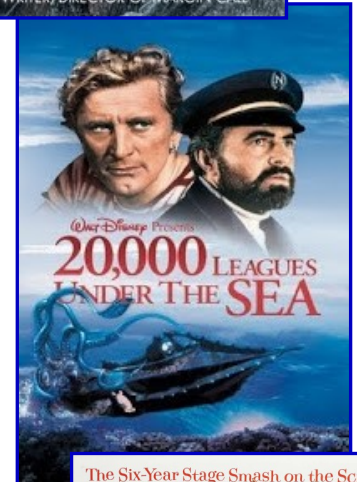
