SHINE Tip of the Month: Check Your Mail for Important Medicare News

Each year beginning in mid-May, the Social Security Administration mails letters to people enrolled in Medicare who are potentially eligible for, but have not enrolled in, Extra Help and Medicare Savings Programs. A SHINE counselor can review the eligibility guidelines with you and assist you in applying for these cost-saving programs.
