

#DIY: RINGLING MACRAME MINIS




IN THE CRAFT BAG:
DOWEL, TEN 3FT LONG CORDS, ONE 2FT LONG CORD
FOR HANGING (THE ONE TIED IN A BOW)

TOOLS NEEDED:
SCISSORS, COMB, WAY TO HANG THE DOWEL


MACRAME SETUP:
REMOVE THE CORD TIED IN A BOW AROUND THE
OTHER CORDS - THAT ONE IS THE SHORTEST AND
WILL BE USED LAST, SO SET IT ASIDE. TAKE YOUR
DOWEL AND FIND A WAY TO HANG IT HORIZONTALLY
FROM SOMETHING (I USED TAPE TO HANG MINE
FROM THE BOTTOM OF SOME CABINETS) SO THAT
YOU CAN TIE THE CORDS ALONG THE CENTER OF THE
DOWEL.

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The knots we'll use:
Lark's head knot
(along the top of the dowel):



Macrame square knot
(forming the upside down
triangle below that):



Double half hitch knot
(two layers to finish
off the bottom of the triangle):
