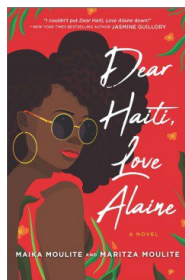

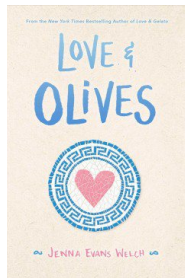

by Maika & Maritza Moulite

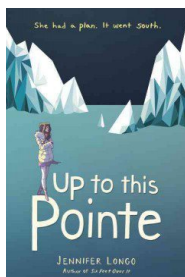

by Jenna Evans Welch

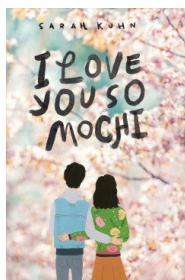

by Jennifer Longo

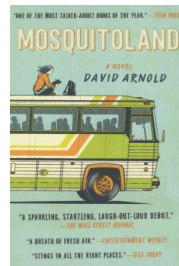

by David Arnold

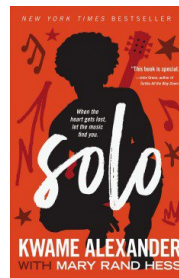

by Lucy Knisley

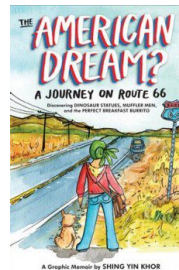

by Kwame Alexander with Mary Rand Hess

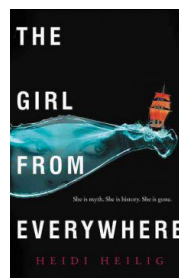
